Antique late-19th Century Austrian Empire solid silver four piece tea service, comprising of a hot water kettle on stand, teapot, sugar bowl and cream jug, decorated with palmette borders, resting on a domed foot and applied with impressive carved handles. Hallmarked Austrian silver (950 standard), Vienna, Maker's mark J.C.K (Joseph Carl Klinkosch, Royal Silversmith, active 1822-1888) was a highly skilled Viennese silversmith, who flourished in 19th Century Europe.
