



## A Victorian Diamond Necklace Offered by The Gilded Lily £45,000.00

A fine diamond necklace made Circa 1860. It is designed with an unusual pattern of alternating single diamonds and six stone diamond clusters, the resultant effect being both substantial, yet delicate, with floral, pansy like, overtones. It was made in England and the claw settings are silver over yellow gold. The diamonds are unusually clean old mine cut stones and the total diamond weight is in excess of 21 carats.
