



Engraved Edwardian 9ct Gold Curb Bracelet with Heart Padlock | c.1910s **£975.00**

For those who know and love antique curb bracelets, this one immediately stands out.

Made in England in the 1910s and fully hallmarked with 375 and FW&S, it carries all the hallmarks of a classic Edwardian piece - elegant proportions, soft rosy 9ct gold - but with that little something extra that makes it unforgettable.

The links alternate between smooth polish and richly engraved textures, adding depth and movement to the bracelet as it catches the light with every turn of the wrist.

It's a subtle detail, but one that gives the piece real rhythm and charm.

Measuring approximately 18cm in length, it closes with its original heart-shaped padlock clasp and safety chain, both in excellent working order.

The gold has the warm tone only antique 9ct develops over time, and the engraving adds just the right amount of softness and visual interest.

There's real character in this bracelet, not just in its design, but in how it wears.

It feels personal, tactile, and full of quiet presence.

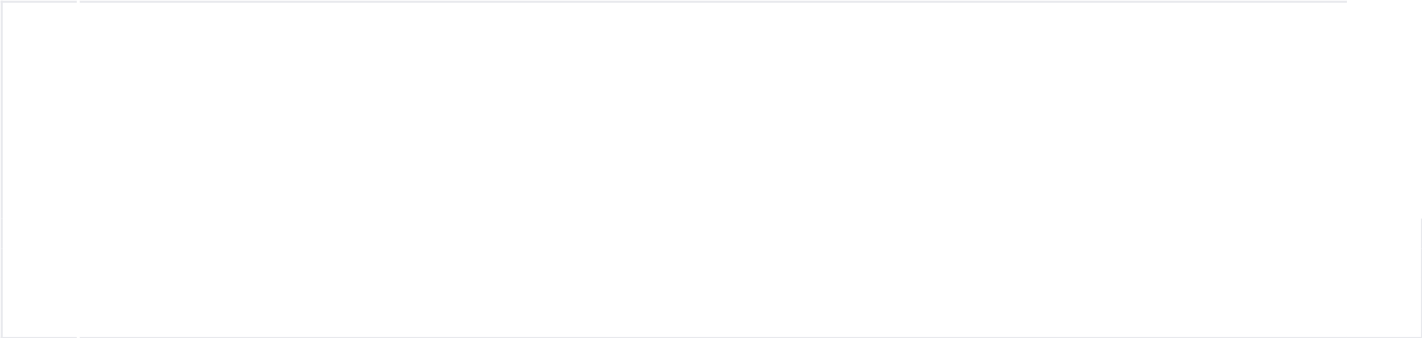
The kind of piece that doesn't just join a collection, it becomes a favourite.
