



Silver Art Deco Panel Bracelet | Square-Cut Smoky Quartz & Marcasite | Germany c.1930s **POA**

A striking piece of German Art Deco design, this bracelet was made in the 1930s by the renowned house of Theodor Fahrner, whose signature appears on the clasp (TF 935).

Crafted in silver, the bracelet combines deeply set square cut smoky quartz with vibrant coral corner accents, and rows of sparkling marcasite.

Measuring 16cm in length and 1.6cm wide, it closes securely with a hidden clasp and safety chain.

Theodor Fahrner's work is celebrated for bringing high-style design to a wider audience, and this piece shows exactly why his name still resonates.
