

Platinum Amethyst & Diamond Art Deco Drop Earrings | English c.1930s POA

A striking pair of 1930s drop earrings, crafted in platinum and set with two vivid pear-cut amethysts weighing approximately seven carats each.

Suspended from a classic articulated line of old-cut diamonds totalling around 1.5 carats, the stones dance with light and movement.

The streamlined silhouette and subtle architectural detailing reflect the elegance of the Art Deco period, while the bold use of colour gives them a timeless, modern energy.

Originally made in England, these earrings combine period finesse with a powerful presence - equally suited to evening glamour or a confident daytime statement.

4.5cm long and 1cm wide at the widest point of the amethyst.
