The openwork floral motif is delicately detailed with milgrain borders and hand-pierced latticework — a hallmark of superior Edwardian craftsmanship. Each diamond is individually set to maximise sparkle while maintaining the brooch's refined, lace-like elegance.

Romantic, graceful, and beautifully preserved, this piece captures the lightness and sophistication that defined the Belle Époque era — a wearable work of art that speaks to over a century of fine jewellery tradition.
