This enchanting crescent brooch, set in 15 carat gold around 1900, captures the delicate elegance of the Edwardian era.

Set with glowing opals totalling approximately 1.90 carats and accented by a vibrant 1 carat of rare faceted cut demantoid garnets, it shimmers with light and colour from every angle.

The opals radiate soft, ethereal fire, while the garnets add a vivid green sparkle - a striking and unusual combination.

Measuring 6cm across, the brooch curves beautifully against the body, evoking celestial grace and timeless romance.

Made in England, it's a poetic piece full of meaning, once worn as a symbol of femininity, intuition, and protection.
