An Art Deco ruby and platinum line bracelet, set with square-cut rubies, in individually linked channel settings, with engraved and open sides, mounted in platinum, with a box and tongue clasp, the clasp is stamped PLAT, circa 1935. Estimated stone weight 5.04 carats.

Line bracelets came into fashion in the 1920s. They have become a design classic and are as popular as ever. They are stackable, often starting with a single diamond bracelet, collections grow with rows of different coloured gemstones, in single colours or alternating gems with diamonds, or medleys of bracelets set with different cuts or sizes of stones.
