



Georgian Brooch & Pendant in 18ct Gold with 2.5ct Old-Cut Diamonds & Cobalt Enamel | c.1825 POA

This extraordinary early 19th-century piece is a celebration of Georgian-era elegance and craftsmanship.

Set in glowing 18-carat gold, it sparkles with approximately 2.5 carats of old-cut diamonds, their soft, romantic shimmer beautifully complemented by deep cobalt-blue guilloché enamel.

The circular design, with its mesmerising concentric rings, has a hypnotic beauty that's both regal and quietly magnetic.

Measuring 2.5cm across, it strikes the perfect balance between bold and wearable.

Thanks to a clever dual fitting, it can be worn either as a brooch or a pendant, offering endless styling potential.

The rope-twist gold border and subtle foil-backing on the stones are hallmarks of Georgian jewellery, likely dating this to around 1825–1835 - a time when every detail was made by hand and designed to be treasured.

Whether pinned to a velvet lapel or suspended from a fine gold chain, this is a jewel that radiates antique glamour, craftsmanship, and timeless allure.
