



Swedish Carnelian Ring in Sculptural 18ct Gold | c.1950s POA

Big, bold, and unapologetically modern - this exceptional Swedish ring from 1954 makes no attempt to blend in.

Crafted in 18ct gold, it holds a large, richly coloured carnelian cabochon that glows with earthy orange-red warmth.

The stone's smooth surface and deep tone give it an almost hypnotic presence, made all the more powerful by the clean, sculptural lines of its setting.

The wide, rounded bezel echoes the curves of the cabochon, creating a seamless frame that sits boldly across the finger.

Measuring an impressive 3.5cm x 3cm at the top, it's a piece that commands attention without a trace of fuss.

Made in Sweden and stamped with full Swedish hallmarks, this ring channels mid-century Scandinavian minimalism with a touch of 1950s glamour - a perfect meeting of restrained design and unapologetic scale.

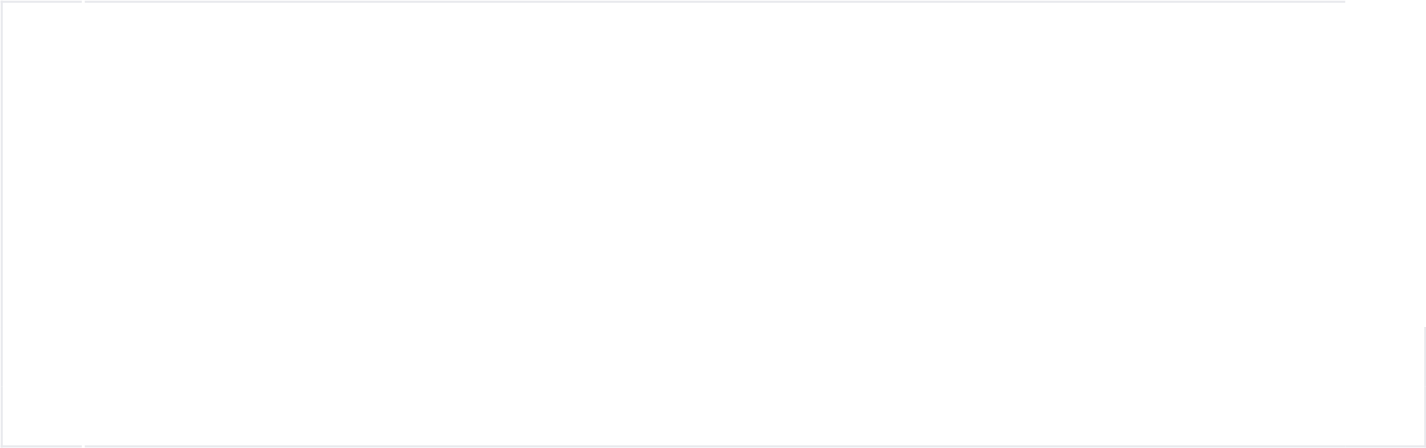
