



Paste-Set Peacock Brooch in Sterling Silver | Colourful Art Deco c.1930s POA

This vibrant 1930s peacock brooch is a joyful piece of craftsmanship, made in sterling silver and set with colourful paste stones in rich jewel tones - deep sapphire blues, emerald greens, citrine yellows, and ruby reds.

The stones are carefully arranged to mimic the peacock's iconic fan of feathers, full of movement and colour.

Measuring 4.5cm high by 5cm wide, it has real presence, bold enough to make a statement, yet refined in its detail.

The design reflects the elegance and flair of the 1930s, when jewellery often took inspiration from nature and was made to be both decorative and expressive.

Long a symbol of beauty and confidence, the peacock is a fitting subject for a brooch like this - playful, proud, and full of charm.
