Framed by two bright old-cut diamonds (0.20 carats total), the sapphires are claw-set in a refined, carved gallery with gentle scrollwork shoulders - a hallmark of Edwardian design that prioritised grace, lightness, and exquisite detail.

This is more than a gemstone ring; it's a piece of living history.

Made in England around the 1900s, its design symbolises loyalty, love, and endurance - qualities traditionally associated with sapphires and diamonds alike.
