





French 18ct Gold Ball Drop Earrings | Boule Icons, c.1960s POA

Elegant, sculptural, and unmistakably French - these vintage 18ct gold drop earrings were made in France in the 1960s and capture the bold simplicity of an era that redefined jewellery design.

Each earring features a highly polished gold sphere—known as the boule—suspended from a delicately detailed hook.

The minimalist shape is anything but plain: the smooth surface reflects light beautifully, creating a warm glow that moves with you.

At 3.5cm long and 1.7cm wide, they're the perfect size for everyday glamour or a refined evening statement.

The boule design rose to prominence in the 1960s, inspired by modernist architecture, sculpture, and the futuristic excitement of the Space Age.

Designers in Paris and Milan began to strip away excess, focusing instead on pure form and proportion. The result? Jewellery that felt fresh, powerful, and incredibly modern, just like these earrings.

Made in solid 18ct gold and hallmarked in France, this pair speaks to effortless sophistication.

They're light enough to wear all day, yet bold enough to stand out.

Whether paired with tailoring or silk, these earrings bring a sense of quiet confidence and timeless style.
