



Georgian Gold Belcher Chain Bracelet | English c.1820, 15ct Gold POA

This exceptional early 19th-century bracelet commands attention with its bold architecture and quiet authority.

Made in England around 1820, its three rows of richly textured belcher links are formed entirely in solid 18ct gold - not just a flourish of the period, but a true investment in weight, craft, and permanence.

The links fasten securely together with a 14ct 1960s box clasp.

The finish is subtly granular, giving the gold a dry, matte gleam that feels as contemporary as it is historical.

At over 31 grams, this is serious 19th century gold jewellery - powerful, grounded, and timeless.
