



## French Diamond Eternity Ring | Platinum & 18ct Gold c.1940s, 3.15ct POA

An exquisite example of post-war French design, this 1940s eternity ring balances precision and softness with effortless grace.

Sculpted in platinum and 18 carat gold, the form curves in a continuous ribbon - a crossover of perfect proportion - set with 3.15 carats of natural round brilliant cut diamonds.

Each stone is finely grain-set, graded G–H in colour and VS1–VS2 in clarity, chosen for clarity, fire, and light.

The diamonds are framed in cool platinum, while a warm gold gallery beneath lends structure and depth.

It's this subtle layering of tone and material that gives the ring its quiet radiance - unmistakably French in its restraint and refinement.

Worn alone, it draws the eye without ever asking for attention. It's the kind of piece that feels natural from the first moment - elegant, sculptural, and intimately made.
