





Gold Eagle Pin with Ruby Eye by Asprey | British c.1950s, with Original Box POA

A finely detailed eagle pin by Asprey, made in England in the 1950s and set in 18 carat white and rose gold with a single ruby eye.

The eagle's wings are outstretched in full flight, its feathers sharply defined, and its expression commanding - a minature sculpture of precision and force.

At just 2cm in height, this piece carries extraordinary presence for its size.

The white gold body is subtly contrasted by rose gold accents, visible in the light as warmth beneath the silver-toned polish.

The ruby is bright, well-set, and catches the light with a glint of red fire.

Marked Asprey 18K to the reverse and fitted with a secure clip mechanism, the piece is presented in its original Asprey box with royal warrant lining.

Jewellery like this wasn't made for ornament alone - it was meant to declare something: loyalty, rank, or personal power.

It wears beautifully on a lapel or pocket, and carries all the weight of British craftsmanship and Asprey's long-standing relationship with the crown.
