



Downstairs at Grays: A fine Edwardian Pendant/Brooch, a central Emerald & Diamond Cluster within a foliate Heart Diamond Set frame suspending a Pear shaped Natural Pearl. Circa 1890 POA

A very fine Edwardian 14 ct. Yellow Gold & Silver (tested), Pendant/Brooch. Centrally set with an Emerald & Diamond Cluster within a foliate stylised Heart Shaped Diamond Set frame suspending a Pear shaped Natural Pearl.

The Emerald has been assessed as being of 1.25 carats; Colombian with minor oil and moderate inclusions. The Diamonds are approximately 3.40 carats of F - G Colour and S1 - SI2 Clarity. The Oval Shaped Pearl is of the Natural Saltwater variety.

This item is accompanied by an Independent Gemmologist's Report confirming the above description.
