

Diamond Brooch in 18ct Gold | 4.5 Carats | British c.1950s POA

A brooch from the 1950s, made in England and set in 18ct gold with approximately 4.5 carats of diamonds.

Designed in a radiating floral motif, it's open in form yet rich in brilliance - a balance of structure and sparkle.

The diamonds are I–J in colour and SI clarity, adding warmth and life to the overall design.

Measuring approximately 4cm in diameter, it wears with poise - as a lapel piece, on silk, or pinned into hair.

Elegant, intricate, and finely made - a classic example of mid-century English diamond work.
