



Georgian Giardinetti Ring with Diamond, Emerald & Ruby | Italian, c.1780 POA

A beautiful 18th-century Georgian Giardinetti ring, believed to have been crafted in Italy around 1780.

Set with a delicate arrangement of diamond, emerald, and ruby to evoke a miniature garden, a style known as Giardinetti ("little garden" in Italian).

The stones are set in silver over gold, a typical technique of the period, preserving both brilliance and elegance.

This rare and romantic design reflects the lightness and sentimentality of 18th-century Italian jewellery, making it a collector's treasure and a timeless piece of antique artistry.
