Transitional cut diamonds represent a fascinating bridge in the history of diamond cutting, occurring between the older European cuts and the modern round brilliant cuts. These diamonds were primarily cut between the 1920s and 1940s, featuring a round shape with a larger table, a higher crown, and a smaller culet than the Old European cut.
