



## Pair of Chinese blue and white lobed dishes Kangxi(1662-1722) POA

Pair of Chinese blue and white lobed dishes Kangxi(1662-1722) painted in the centre with a lady in a rocky garden next to a jardiner of flowers, with radiating panels alternative decorated with a lady and flowers the reverse with scrolling flowers, one with leaf in the centre the other with the symbol for jade

Notes:

The Chinese symbol for jade is 玉. It is pronounced "yù" in Mandarin and is used to represent jade in various forms, including jade objects and jade-related concepts. The character itself is thought to have originated from a pictograph of jade pieces hanging on a string
