While a formal "history of amethyst pearl rings" isn't documented, the ring style likely emerged from the established traditions of amethyst use by royalty and clergy, and the long-standing fashion for pearls, especially during the Victorian and Edwardian eras when such combining styles were popular, as evidenced by antique examples of the rings from these periods. Amethyst was prized for its symbolism and colour, appearing in rings for bishops, while pearls were frequently used as accents in jewellery from the 19th century onwards.
