An English Edwardian diamond ring from the 1910s, featuring two rows of old cut diamonds totalling approximately 0.70 carats, set in platinum above an 18 carat yellow gold band.

The platinum setting is finished in smooth rub over style, and the open gallery allows light to enhance the diamonds' natural brilliance. A refined and timeless example of early twentieth century craftsmanship.
