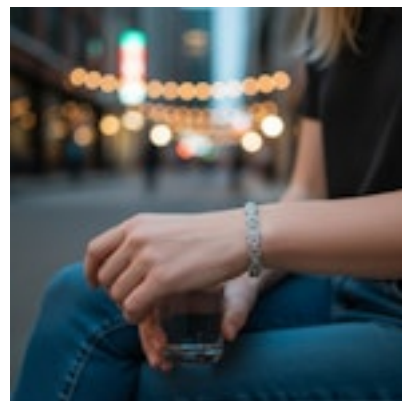




Late Art-Deco Diamond Bracelet

A superb late Art-Deco diamond bracelet, crafted in 18k white gold and set with an impressive total of approximately 9.5 carats of transitional-cut diamonds.

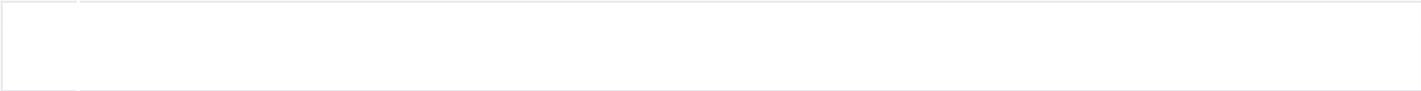
