



Meissen Commedia dell'arte figure POA

19th century Meissen figure from the Commedia dell'arte series originally commissioned by the Duke of Sachs-Weissenfels and executed by Kaendler in 1774. The series comprised 18 figures mostly based on engravings by François Joullain from Louis Riccoboni's *Histoire du theatre Italien*. This figure depicts Pagliaccio which was produced around 1890
