Large and impressive Meiji period Japanese bronze screen, the main body on feet with coiling dragons to the bottom and sides, a large bird of prey surmounted on the perch which has phoenixes at either end. The well modelled hawk is in two parts, talons affixed to the perch. The screen made in two sliding sections, front inlaid with quails, the reverse with female deities and a child bearing fruit on a dragon

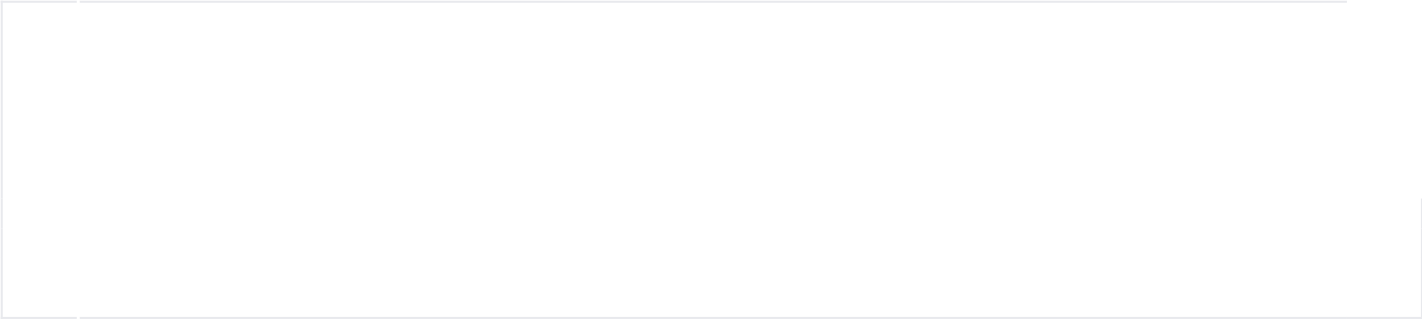
