Georg Jensen jewellery began in 1904 when silversmith Georg Jensen opened his Copenhagen shop, blending his artistic and sculptural background with a love for nature to create elegant, functional designs. His work, inspired by the Art Nouveau movement, was defined by flowing lines and organic forms, but also an emphasis on clean lines and functionality that became the cornerstone of Scandinavian design. After his death in 1935, the company continued his legacy, gaining international acclaim for its high-quality, timeless pieces that continue to be produced today.
