A beautifully refined example of a Victorian three-stone diamond gypsy ring, crafted in rich 18K yellow gold during the late 19th century, in the enduring style popularised throughout the reign of Queen Victoria.

Elegant in its simplicity, the ring features three old-cut diamonds set seamlessly into the gently domed gold band—a classic gypsy setting, designed to offer both durability and a smooth, uninterrupted surface. The result is a piece that feels as wearable today as it did over a century ago.

At its centre sits an old-cut diamond of approximately 0.25 carat, flanked by two further old-cut diamonds, bringing the total diamond weight to approximately 0.50 carat. Each stone displays the soft, understated brilliance characteristic of antique cuts—subtle, warm, and full of individual character.

Presented in excellent condition, with well-preserved settings and a pleasingly smooth gold finish. The low-profile design makes this ring exceptionally comfortable—ideal for everyday wear.

Lightweight yet substantial enough to feel considered, it sits effortlessly on the hand and pairs beautifully with both modern and antique pieces.
