1938 Silver Link Necklace. A striking original Art Deco sterling silver necklace, hallmarked in London in 1938. The back also features a K.LTD makers mark. The necklace is composed of substantial circular links joined by geometric silver connectors, each accented with polished sphere details that perfectly capture the clean, architectural styling of the late Art Deco period. The bold design reflects the streamlined modernity that defined jewellery of the 1930s, balancing strong geometric forms with elegant movement and wearability. Beautifully constructed in solid sterling silver, the neck chain measures 18.5inches and weighs 48.6g. Increasingly sought after, pieces from this period embody a timeless sophistication that remains remarkably contemporary today. At the end of the chain there is a seamless bolt ring fastening. 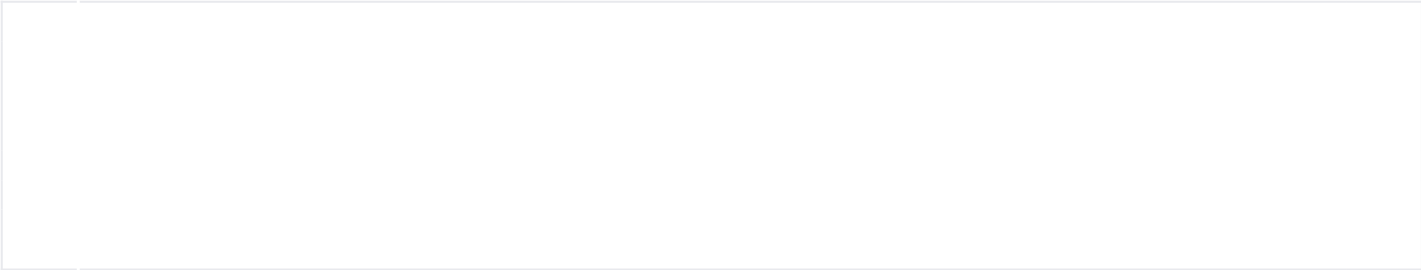
