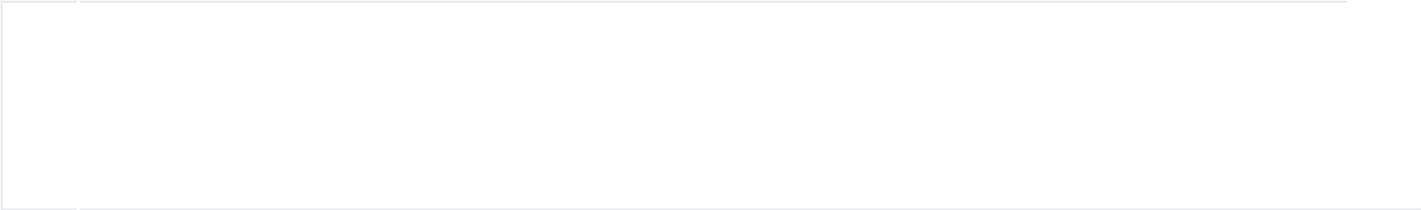
Victorian Diamond Swallow Necklace. A charming and highly symbolic Victorian diamond swallow necklace dating to circa 1880, beautifully crafted in silver-topped 15ct gold and set with sparkling diamonds. The swallow, captured in graceful flight with outstretched wings, is one of the most beloved motifs of the Victorian era, representing love, loyalty, safe return, and enduring affection. The swallow is finely detailed, with pave set diamonds adorning the body and wings, while a ruby cabochon eye provides a subtle flash of colour and character. Suspended from a delicate light rose gold chain, the pendant sits elegantly at the collarbone, making it as wearable today as it was over a century ago. Bird and swallow jewellery became particularly popular during the late Victorian period, often exchanged as sentimental gifts between loved ones. Their enduring symbolism and timeless design continue to make them highly sought after by collectors and jewellery enthusiasts alike.
