The undisputed star of the show here is the original silver linen dial. Up close, it features a beautiful, cross-hatched woven texture that catches the light in a way standard flat dials just can't match. It adds an incredible layer of depth and character while keeping that ultra-clean, minimalist look.

The stainless steel case has a classic 34mm footprint—the perfect, understated vintage size that slips right under a cuff. It also features its correct, original Omega-signed crown. We've paired this piece with a lovely, high-quality blue leather strap, which creates a striking contrast that makes the textured linen dial absolutely pop.

Inside, it is powered by the legendary manual-wind Omega Calibre 600. Highly regarded by watchmakers for its robust build, slim profile, and ease of service, it winds smoothly and ticks away reliably. It's a beautifully simple, elegant vintage watch that brings a ton of classic style to the wrist without screaming for attention.
