If you love the bold, funky design vibe of the 1970s, this Omega De Ville from 1974 is a total mood. It moves completely away from traditional round watches, opting for a cool, softly squared cushion case with a rich gold-plated finish that gives it a ton of presence on the wrist.

But let's talk about the real showstopper: the black textured dial. Photos honestly don't do this justice—this is one of those watches you absolutely have to see in person. While it isn't in absolute flawless, factory-perfect condition, the way the light catches that unique, gridded texture is incredible. It gives the dial a moody, dark depth that a standard flat black dial could never match. It has an amazing vintage character that tells a story.

To be totally transparent, the crown was swapped out for a non-Omega replacement at some point over the decades. However, it completely makes up for it where it counts: the mechanics. The watch has just had a full mechanical service. The legendary automatic Omega Calibre 1012 movement inside is ticking flawlessly, winding like butter, and ready for daily wear.

If you want something unique, full of '70s style, and completely ready to wear without worrying about a trip to the watchmaker, this is a killer pick.
