If you want a vintage watch that brings serious wrist presence without being loud or over-the-top, this 1968 Omega Seamaster is an absolute masterclass. Cross-referencing the archives puts its production year right at the peak of Omega's golden era, and it has aged beautifully.

The first thing you notice about this reference is the beefy, beefier-than-usual 36.5mm stainless steel case. Back in the '60s, most dressy watches were a bit smaller, but this "Jumbo" case features thick, broad lugs that make it wear with a fantastic, modern weight on the wrist. This particular example comes in good condition with a really clean case, and it features its original, signed Omega crown. We've paired it with a plain black leather strap to lean into a sharp, sporty look that goes with absolutely anything.

The stunning, ultra-clean silver dial features a day-date window at 3 o'clock and sharp, applied baton markers with black inserts that give it a great architectural pop. Under the hood, the watch has just been fully serviced. It's powered by the legendary, 24-jewel automatic Omega Calibre 752.

Watchmakers love this movement family because it is incredibly robust and features a genius quickset date mechanism—you just pull the crown out to advance the date forward instantly.

It is the perfect everyday vintage piece: tough, fully refreshed, and packed with that high-grade mid-century engineering that made Omega famous.
