Edwardian Diamond Cluster Ring. A beautiful Edwardian diamond cluster ring crafted in 18ct yellow gold topped with platinum, featuring approximately 0.45 carats of old-cut diamonds arranged in an elegant floral cluster design. The cluster is centred by a sparkling old-cut diamond surrounded by a halo of similarly matched diamonds, each individually millegrain-set to enhance their brilliance. Delicate diamond-set shoulders add further refinement, whilst the openwork gallery beneath the cluster demonstrates the exceptional craftsmanship associated with the Edwardian period. The combination of platinum and yellow gold was a hallmark of fine Edwardian jewellery, allowing the diamonds to appear brighter whilst retaining the warmth and richness of a gold shank. The finely pierced gallery and intricate millegrain detailing create a wonderfully feminine appearance that remains as desirable today as it was over a century ago. An elegant and timeless antique diamond ring, ideal as an engagement ring, anniversary gift or addition to a fine antique jewellery collection.
