The richly coloured ruby displays the coveted vivid red hue for which Burmese rubies have been admired for centuries. Encircling the centre stone is a finely matched cluster of old-cut diamonds, each individually set within platinum to maximise brilliance and showcase the exceptional craftsmanship of the period. The combination of platinum and 18ct yellow gold became a defining characteristic of fine Edwardian jewellery, allowing diamonds to appear brighter while retaining the warmth and richness of a gold shank. Inside the shank is a 'ETIME 1538' mark Delicate millegrain detailing and the softly cushion-shaped cluster lend the ring a refined elegance that continues to captivate collectors and antique jewellery enthusiasts.
