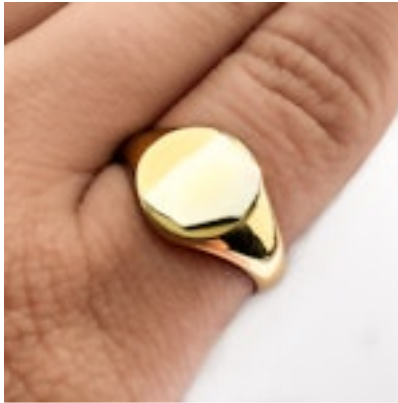




**1913 Oxford Gold Signet Ring - Saddingtons Jewellery Stand 375
