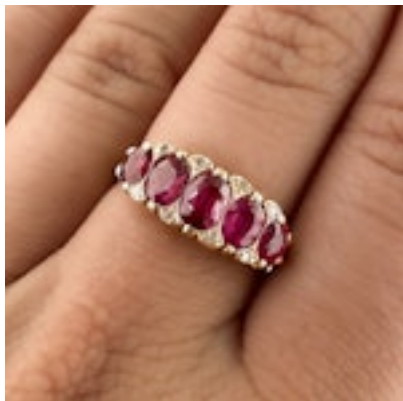




**Edwardian 5 Stone Burma Ruby Ring - Saddingtons Jewellery Stand 375
