The harmonious arrangement of gemstones creates an attractive floral cluster, while elegant scrolling shoulders and beaded details add further refinement and unmistakable Victorian character. Acrostic jewellery became highly fashionable during the Victorian era, with jewellers using the first letter of each gemstone to create hidden messages of love, friendship and devotion. “REGARD” was among the most popular and enduring sentiments, making these rings highly collectable today for both their symbolism and craftsmanship.
