



Edwardian 9ct Gold and Silver Opal and Diamond Bracelet- Spectrum Antiques

A delicate Edwardian bracelet, its nine opal cabochons glowing softly in 9ct gold claw settings, linked by elaborate pierced scrollwork set through with old and rose-cut diamonds. The scrolls are worked in silver-topped gold, the classic Edwardian pairing that lets the diamonds sit crisp and bright against a warmer gold structure beneath — a hallmark of the garland style at its most refined.

The opals bring a gentle, shifting colour to the piece, playing beautifully off the sparkle of the diamond scrollwork. It fastens with a spring ring clasp and safety chain, and wears with the light, airy elegance so characteristic of the period — a lovely, wearable piece of early twentieth-century jewellery.
