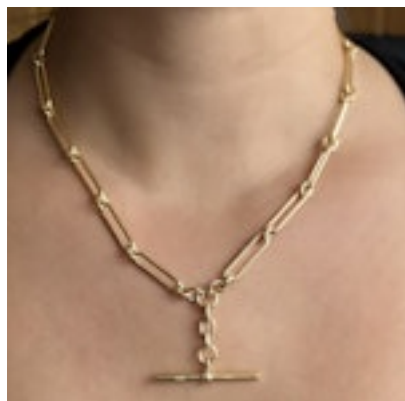

This 1923 18? Gold Trombone Link Albert Chain is a particularly substantial antique example, weighing an impressive 42.2 grams and bearing Chester hallmarks for 1923. Crafted in rich 9ct yellow gold, the chain features classic elongated trombone links joined by rounded connecting links, together with its traditional T-bar and dog clip fittings. Originally designed as a gentleman's watch chain, Albert chains have become highly sought-after antique necklaces, prized for their distinctive links, versatility and substantial gold weight. At 18 inches, this is a very wearable length, while the generous 42.2g weight gives it a wonderfully substantial feel. A strong, beautifully made piece of early Art Deco jewellery that works equally well worn alone or with a favourite antique pendant or fob.
