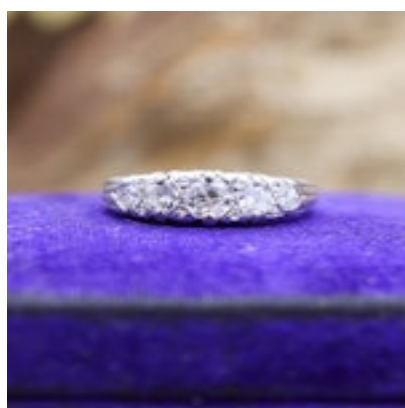
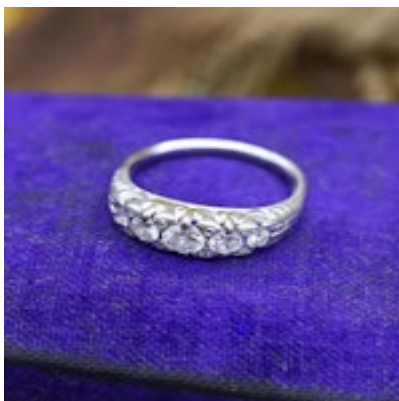
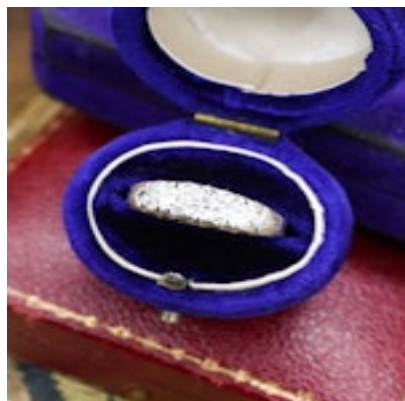




18ct White Gold Five Stone Diamond Ring Circa 1910-1920 POA
