



A very fine Colombian Emerald & Diamond Three Stone Ring set in 18ct White Gold, Circa 1955

This exquisite mid-century three-stone ring centres on a vibrant 0.70 carat Oval Cut Colombian Emerald, held securely in a classic raised claw setting.

The rich green gemstone displays the characteristic moderate inclusions and traditional moderate oil enhancement expected of fine Colombian origin, radiating a captivating depth of colour.

Flanking the central Emerald are two bright round Brilliant Cut Diamonds, estimated at 0.80 carats in total. Graded G to H for colour and SI1 to SI2 for clarity, they provide a crisp, scintillating contrast to the verdant green. The stones are elegantly mounted in 18 Carat White Gold, capturing the sophisticated design sensibilities of circa 1955.

Accompanied by an independent gemmological report confirming its Colombian provenance and stone specifications, this timeless piece makes a refined statement for any collection.
