



**Vintage Etruscan Revival Natural Sapphire Ring in 18k Yellow Gold,

A striking example of late twentieth-century Etruscan Revival jewellery, this substantial ring is crafted in solid 18k yellow gold and set with three natural sapphire cabochons of rich royal blue colour.

Hallmarked for 18k gold and dated 1970, London, the ring reflects the renewed fascination with ancient goldsmithing techniques that swept through British jewellery design during the late 1960s and early 1970s. The broad, sculptural form is enhanced by textured gold surfaces, applied granulation-inspired borders and smooth bezel-set sapphire cabochons, all characteristic of the archaeological revival aesthetic that drew inspiration from the treasures of the ancient Mediterranean world.

The central oval sapphire is flanked by two smaller matching cabochons, creating a bold yet harmonious composition. The substantial gold mount weighs an impressive 13.15 grams, giving the ring exceptional presence on the hand while remaining comfortable to wear.

Distinctive, collectible and unmistakably of its era, this is a piece that bridges ancient inspiration and modern design. Its confident proportions and rich gold colour make it equally suited to everyday wear or inclusion within a curated collection of period jewellery.

A wonderful example of 1970s Etruscan Revival design, offering both visual impact and enduring craftsmanship.
