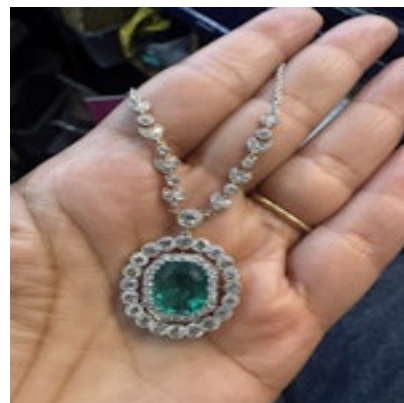
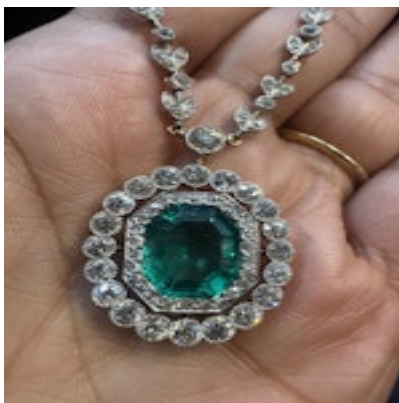




AN ART DECO COLOMBIAN EMERALD AND DIAMOND PENDANT NECKLACE POA

Emerald and diamond pendant, ca.1920. Fable&Windsor, Stand 354-355

A fine Colombian emerald, framed by a millegrain-set diamond surround and an outer border of old-cut diamonds.

The pendant is suspended from an elegant platinum necklace of foliate design, composed of alternating diamond-set leaf motifs and collet-set diamonds.

Accompanied by a report from The Gem & Pearl Laboratory, dated 23 July 2021, stating that the emerald is of Colombian origin with minor clarity enhancement.

Emerald measurements: approximately 12.5–13.0 × 9.9 × 6.2mm

Total weight: 10.87g

Metal: Platinum

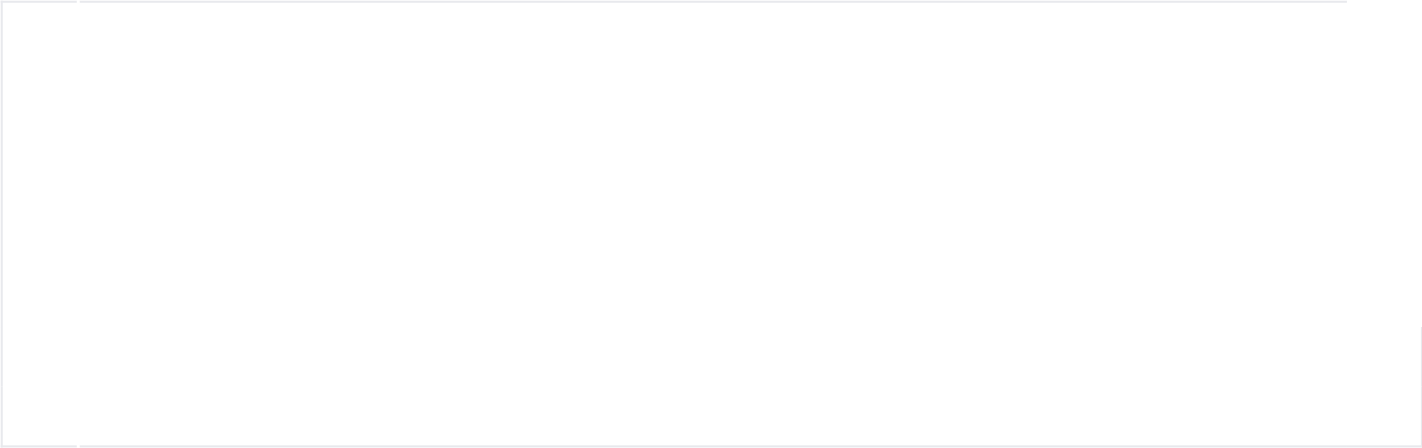
Period: Art Deco, circa 1920

A particularly elegant example of early Art Deco jewellery, combining the strong geometry of the period with delicate millegrain work and an important Colombian emerald.
