Chinese famille verte ribbed charger, Kangxi (1662-1722), decorated in the centre with a roundel containing a basket of flowers within a cellular border interspersed by cartouches containing Daoist emblems, the cavetto divided into twelve panels of flowers including lotus, peony, chrysanthemum and cherry blossom with flowerheads to the rim against a green ground; diameter: 15 ¼ in. (38.6 cm.); condition: small chips to rim
