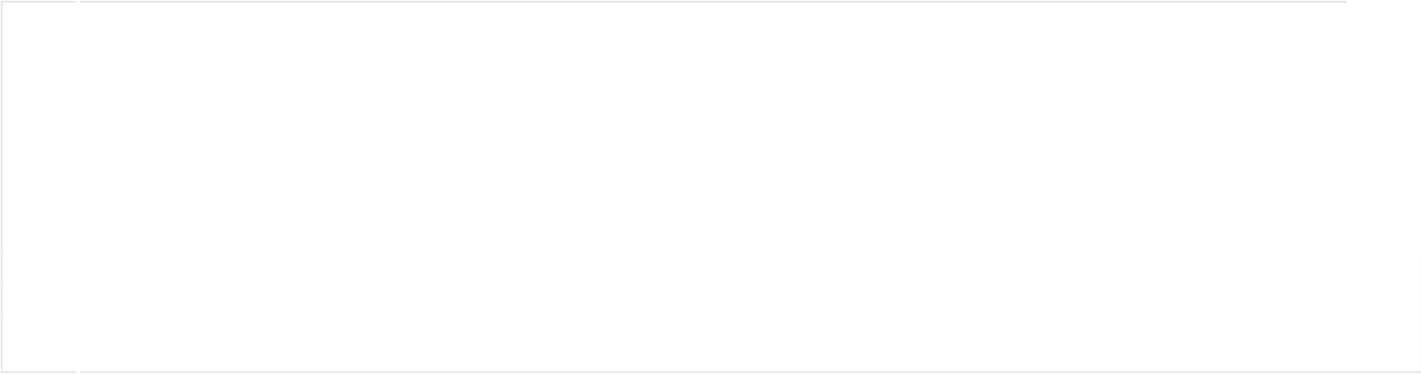




Wood Okimono POA

This 19th century signed Japanese wood Okimono is a very quirky subject depicting what appears to be an ugly woman but is actually a woman wearing a grotesque mask performing a tea ceremony seated with her wares before her. The wood finely carved and patinated, signed on a red lacquer seal Meiji period circa 1880
