Okimono cast in two separate section - Eagle and Fish, fitted together. Figure represents a strong Eagle spreading its wings over a caught Dragon Fish. Okimono very expressive and powerful.

For Japan the eagle is a symbol of the great power of nature .

In Edo Period images of Eagle or Hawk were commissioned by Samurais and became a symbol of their status and warrior spirit
