



Pair Japanese Bronze Candlesticks Meiji Period.

A very unusual pair of Candlesticks made in Bronze in late 19 century for European market.

Each of Candlestick depicts the folkloric Creature “ Kappa “sitting on a Lotus leaf. The head of each Kappa is covered with a small lotus leaf, in its paws Kappa holds an unopened lotus shoot.

If you look closely, you will also see Frogs and Snails peacefully resting on lotus leaves.

It's a serene summer day for the magic inhabitants of the village pond.

Kappa are typically depicted as green, human-like being with webbed hands and feet and Turtle- like carapace on their backs..
