A: The History of Zimbabwean Emeralds.

The presence of emeralds in this area was discovered relatively late in 1956 by the prospectors Laurence Contat and Cornelius Oosthuizen who had been attracted by the offerings that the Rhodesian government was making at the time to prospectors of metals and gemstones.
