Likely made in Britain around 1915, these earrings reflect the refined glamour of the period - elegant, wearable, and quietly luxurious.

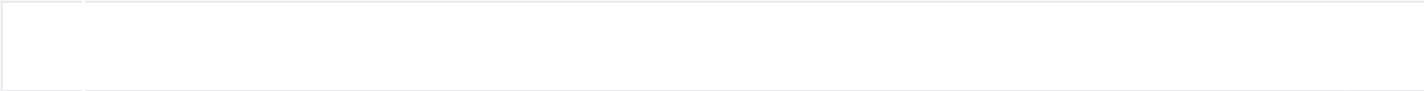
The platinum settings are finely crafted with millegrain edging, while the closed-back gold mounts add warmth and historical charm.
